



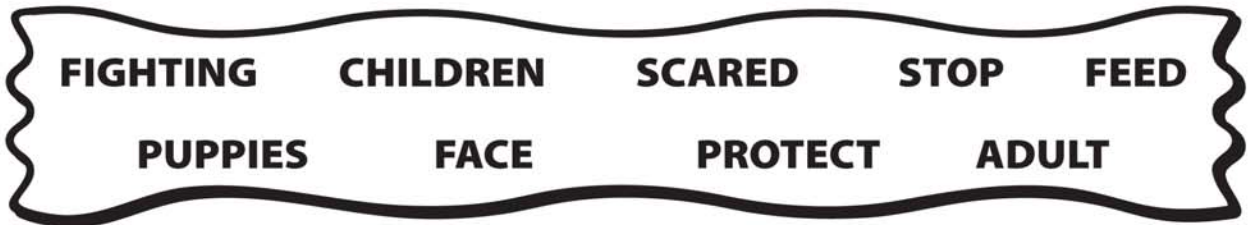
DOG SAFETY GAMES
